

WA Republicans are not unaware of the weakness and vulnerabilities of our state's elections. Even if we weren't aware prior to 2004, the Rossi-Gregoire gubernatorial election was an undeniable wake-up call to the reality that Democrats could not only cheat the people of WA State out of a fair election, but also to get away with it in WA courts.

Sixteen years have since passed, and those who have been paying attention have watched as a democrat-controlled legislatures have systematically worked to undermine election security and integrity in WA state through the removal of checks and balances and the creation of firewalls that obfuscate truth, eliminate transparency, and leave us with little-to-no recourse for change.

- We know non-citizens are registering to vote (many accidentally).
- We know we can't track our own ballot past signature verification.
- We know it's impossible to independently verify that our vote was counted properly.
- We know there are multiple instances where hundreds of voters are registered to the exact same, non-residential address.
- We know democrats are using tax dollars to fund projects that target homeless and felon populations with voter registration education.
- We know members of Antifa/BLM were registering, as homeless, in King County districts, despite coming from other areas to stay temporarily in order to riot.
- We know democrats use ballot-return data ("match-backs") to harvest ballots.
- We know over a million ballots aren't returned each election.
- We know that Tribal IDs can now be used to register to vote, and that the state has no authority to verify their authenticity with Tribal membership documents.
- We know democrats have been changing election laws to make WA elections easier to cheat while making it harder for anyone else to prove.
- We have met people who assert they can't vote because they're a green-card holder, but our databases show they are registered and have voted (multiple times).
- We have found stacks of ballots and voter registration cards in garbage cans next to mailboxes for housing complexes.
- We have watched democrats "find" ballots until they came from behind enough to win an election.
- And we have reported many of these vulnerabilities and concerns to the county, the state, and even the FBI...yet have seen no changes implemented in response.

Voter concerns about election integrity in WA are more than justified.

The KCGOP Election Integrity Committee was formed in order to allow King County republicans to collaborate and organize an effort to effectively address the election-integrity concerns of King County voters. While the committee is just getting started, it has already been working to ascertain what avenues of recourse are viable and what resources and people are needed to pursue those avenues, while uniting with election integrity groups across the region so key areas of election integrity can be addressed efficiently and effectively.

Whether there are thousands of specific examples of fraud, or just a few hundred, or even just concerns that state policies (like non-citizens getting drivers' licenses) could be exploited to commit fraud—voters have a right to ASSURANCE of election integrity, and right now in WA state, a majority of Republicans simply don't have that assurance.

The KCGOP Election Integrity Committee has been working to find the best ways to change that, and we want you to be informed so you know how you can help. We hope you will join us in fighting for assurance that our vote counts, so we might be confident the TRUE voice of the People of Washington is heard.

The State of WA Elections: The Bad News

WA Elections lack security and integrity in a couple key areas

- 1. Voter Registration
 - a. A person can register without any ID
 - b. Tribal IDs are now acceptable (even though the state has no authority to audit Tribal Membership Rolls
 - c. WA's DOL will not/cannot share essential voter-eligibility information with the Sec. of State's office
 - d. It appears National Change of Address audits are not being done regularly
 - e. Voter rolls don't appear to be well-maintained (significant numbers of Deceased voters, Felons, Out-of-State residents, etc. received ballots)
 - f. Non-citizens on registration rolls: we are a sanctuary state, that gives licenses to non-citizens, that has NEVER run an audit of voter rolls to remove non-citizens.

2. Mail-in balloting

- a. Ballots are mailed out to EVERYONE on the voter rolls
- b. Millions of unused ballots are mailed out every election
- c. No way to verify the person filling out the ballot is the correct person
- d. No ballot tracking with confirmation a vote was properly counted
- a. Rossi/Gregoire 2004 showed it is easy for Democrats to "find" ballots until they win

3. Elections Systems

- a. Electronic tallying is not auditable by the voter and requires voters
- b. Electronic systems were originally developed for the purpose of manipulating results to cheat elections
- c. All elections systems use the same base code (Dominion, Diebold, ES&S, HART InterCivic, Sequoia, Smartmatic, etc, all run on code originally developed by **OpTech** in 1974)
- d. Elections systems are still capable of being used to manipulate results and cheat
- e. Tallying software/firmware is not independently audited for manipulative code (elections systems companies actively fight against this, citing proprietary code, but this would normally be addressed by the auditor signing a non-disclosure agreement).

4. Recounts

- a. Current process for recounting does not eliminate the ability to manipulate the vote
- b. Recounting fraudulent ballots doesn't eliminate fraud
- c. Democrats have a history of "finding" ballots until they win
- d. King County recounts are unreasonably expensive as the county charges thousands of dollars in "overhead" rather than just \$.25/\$.50 per ballot
- e. State-wide elections can be stolen from the people of WA by way of cheating in a handful of select counties, namely, King County

WA Currently Suffers Under a One-Party Governmental System

- 1. Democrat controlled legislature
 - a. Good legislation will be ignored
 - b. Bad legislation will pass
- 2. Judges now block attempts to correct for lack of legislative representation; whatever election they can't cheat us out of, they can just sue us out of later
- 3. If our elections are rigged and our courts are corrupt, then we cannot elect good judges, we cannot sue to fix bad election laws, and we cannot elect good legislators to pass good legislation so we can fix bad election laws and elect good judges.

What We're Doing

KCGOP Election Integrity Committee

- 1. Starting Premises
 - a. Voters have a right to assurance of election integrity
 - b. Governing officials have an obligation to <u>protect election integrity</u> and to <u>provide voters with</u> independently verifiable information concerning that integrity
 - c. If we don't have election integrity or the ability to secure the integrity of our elections:
 - i. Our vote doesn't matter
 - ii. Democracy doesn't exist
 - iii. Our Republic is dead
- 2. KCGOP Election Integrity Committee Goals (Work In Progress):
 - a. Develop and maintain a comprehensive understanding of WA Election problems/concerns
 - b. Create public awareness of problems and solutions
 - c. Network with a coalition of election integrity advocates and activists
 - d. Stay on top of newly-proposed, related legislation
 - e. Gather and discuss related information and evidence
 - f. Analyze potential avenues for action
 - g. Form sub-committees to work on each avenue
 - h. Collaborate with and lobby government officials for support and action
 - i. Collaborate with coalition members and legislators to develop initiatives and legislation
 - j. Work with attorneys when appropriate to advocate for WA voters through litigation
 - k. Train and support grass-roots efforts to fight for election integrity
 - I. Regularly update WA Voters
- 3. Current Priorities
 - a. Audit voter rolls for non-citizens
 - i. Sue for DOL database access (if only we had a REAL AG)
 - ii. Use E-Verify (even if it won't identify all non-citizens)
 - iii. Use DHS Citizenship Database released last year
 - iv. Release data (Is it enough to overturn some elections?)
 - v. Purge fraudulent registrations from voter rolls
 - vi. If our current registration rolls cannot be audited to remove non-citizens, WE SHOULD NOT BE USING THEM
 - b. Audit Elections software/firmware
 - i. Sue for a publicly verifiable, independent audit with signed non-disclosure
 - ii. Look for manipulative code (e.g. fractional voting algorithms, etc.)
 - iii. Look for evidence of fraudulent activity (e.g. high rate of adjudication, manual transfer of votes from one candidate to another, etc.)
 - iv. If our current elections systems can't be independently and publicly audited, WE SHOULD NOT BE USING THEM
 - c. OPPOSE BAD LEGISLATION
 - i. HB 1068 will make audit results exempt from public disclosure
 - ii. <u>SB 5250</u> will give leftists complete control over the voter pamphlet language of <u>citizens'</u> <u>initiatives</u> (both "For" and "Against" statements)

How You Can Get Involved

- 1. Observe/attend our meetings
- 2. Report known instances of election irregularities, fraud, and suspected fraud
- 3. Petition Sec. of State, WA State Auditor, King County Elections, and King County Auditor for:
 - a. Audits of voter rolls for non-citizens
 - b. Audits of our elections software/firmware for manipulated code and nefarious activity
- 4. OPPOSE HB 1068 and SB 5250
- 5. Support Good Legislation (thought we don't expect it to get a fair hearing)
 - a. HB 1003 would require ballots to have identifiable watermarks
 - b. HB 1360 would not allow ballots missing postmarks to be counted
 - c. HB 1014 would give WA it's own electoral college for gubernatorial elections
 - d. HB 1377 would require in-person voting
 - e. HB 1361 would help ensure ballots are mailed in a timely manner
 - f. <u>HB 1265</u> would change declaration requirements for presidential primaries
 - g. SB 5143 would implement in-person voting, voter ID requirements, etc.
